The Preston & District Charity Cup

- 1. Payment of the Association Annual Subscription registers every eligible player of that Club.
- 2. Each club will pay an entry fee for a team of 17 players plus the Captain or Club Official making a team of 18 players in total. The team will be selected from Club Qualifying Competitions through the year. The entry fee will provide prizes and a donation to a Local Charity. The Host Club will choose the Charity.
- 3. The format will be a Singles Stableford Competition. Incorporating a team competition.
- 4. Playing Handicap will be calculated as 95% of each player's Course Handicap with a **maximum Playing Handicap of 18**.
- 5. The highest aggregate total from the best 12 Stableford points score will be used to decide the winning team. In the event of a tie the thirteenth score to count and so on until a winner is declared.
- 6. There will be prizes for 1^{st} Team and 1^{st} 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} best points score.
- 7. The Host club will provide facilities and Competition Officials to assist the Executive Officials on the day. The Executive Council will be responsible for all arrangements for the day.
