

Preston & District Guild Cup

1. Payment of the Association Annual Subscription registers every eligible player of that Club.
2. Each club will pay an entry fee for a team of 10 pairs i.e. 20 players of which the Captain & President will make up 2 players.
3. Each Club to hold a Qualifying Competition in a Fourball Betterball format, to determine the 20 players and reserves.
4. **In the event of a qualifying player or pair not being able to participate in the finals day. They should both be replaced by the next highest available reserves from the qualifying event.**
5. The format will be Four- Ball Better Ball Stableford.
6. Each player will have a calculated Playing Handicap - 85% of their Course Handicap - the Maximum Playing Handicap for any player shall be 18.
7. The aggregate points from the best 8 pairs to decide the winning team. In the event of a tie the ninth score to count and so on until a winner is declared.
8. There will be prizes for 1st Team and 1st and 2nd Pairs.
9. The Host club will provide facilities and Competition Officials to assist the Executive Officials on the day. The Executive Council will be responsible for all arrangements for the day.
